## Grants, Scholarships, and Awards Approved for Funding in 2019

- Two \$500 Robert and Ruth Nyquist scholarships to graduating seniors at the **Bainville Public High School**, 409 Tubman Street, Bainville, MT 59212.
- \$200 to the **Culbertson Museum**, Box 95, Culbertson, MT 59218 toward the upgrading of the museum bathroom.
- \$1,076.95 to the **Culbertson Public Library**, 307 Broadway Avenue, Culbertson, MT 59218 to purchase five chairs to be used in conjunction with the library's computer stations.
- \$2,000 to the **Town of Froid**, P.O. Box 308, Froid, MT 59226 toward the cost of repairing and updating the ground source heating and cooling system for the Froid Community Center.
- \$400 in support of a Community Essay Contest at the local high school administered by the **Froid Public Library**, 101 2nd Street North, Froid, MT 59226.
- \$1,000 to the **Froid Public Library**, 101 2nd Street North, Froid, MT 59226, to be used for the years 2019-2022 to augment the Montana Collection of books and materials.
- \$900 to **Historic Huguenot Street**, 88 Huguenot Street, New Paltz, NY 12561 to support a series of four guided tours through the Nyquist-Harcourt Wildlife Sanctuary that focus on native plants and their cultural significance, particularly as it relates to the Esopus Muncie Indians.
- \$1,900 to the **Millbrook Preserve**, 21 Calvin Road, New Paltz, NY 12561 to install forty bog bridges in the preserve.
- \$600 to the **Mohonk Preserve**, P.O. Box 175, New Paltz, NY 12561 toward piloting a new blazing method for the Bonticou Craig trail using medallions rather than painted markers.
- \$2,000 to the **Phillies Bridge Farm Project**, 45 Phillies Bridge Road, New Paltz, NY 12561 to provide 20 partial scholarships for children of low income families to attend the Farm Summer Day Camp for a week.
